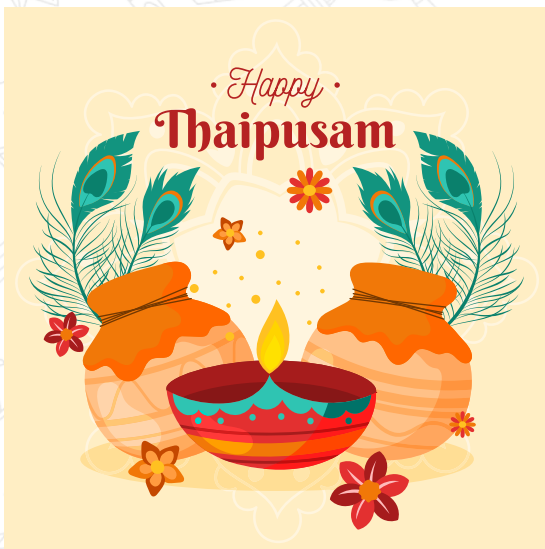

When asked to describe the ocean inhabitants, one will not fail to include the sea turtles. What about these majestic sea creatures that are synonymous with the wave? Whatever answers you hold, being Malaysians, we are blessed with the presence of four remarkable turtle species gracing our beaches and representing our national identity. In September 2021, 275 students and 30 teachers from Melaka had successfully participated in the Turtle Conservation Education Competition, a biodiversity education initiative by the Green Growth Asia Foundation featuring five unique lesson plans, two webinars and one challenge module. At the end of their journey, participants pledged their support to stop the consumption of turtle eggs, bringing us a step closer to achieving a future where animals and man can co-exist peacefully.

On January 25, GGAF organised a sharing session with teachers from Eco-Schools Perak. We invited Puan Siti Faizah binti Hassan from Sekolah Kebangsaan Bukit Lintang to share her experience conducting the programme in 2018. SK Bukit Lintang achieved the 'Green Flag' award, the highest international Eco-Schools award that acknowledges, rewards and celebrates the ecological achievements of young people in just 1 year and 6 months. Puan Faizah demonstrated SK Bukit Lintang's achievements with a slide presentation, detailing the process of the school's 7-Step Methodology.

On January 19, Eco-Schools Perak completed its first series of workshops with teachers from 20 schools at the M Roof Hotel & Residences, Ipoh. The objective of the day was to introduce the programme and furnish the schools with the knowledge and materials to prepare their Eco-Schools Action Plan. At the beginning of the workshop, card games about carbon were played to give the teachers a view of how climate change is happening and the major factor of its cause. Followed by an overall view of the Eco-Schools Programme and an Eco-Schools Audit where each school is required to submit their school's data on electricity and water consumption, waste and litter productions as well as their history of green programs. After lunch and prayers, the day continued with a more technical approach to the Eco-Schools Programme with the development of the Action Plan.
