ECO-SCHOOLS PROGRAMME IS THE LEADING PARTNER IN UN GREENING EDUCATION PARTNERSHIP.

The UN Greening Education Partnership is a global initiative to support countries for accelerating the implementation of climate change education in response to climate crisis. It aims to deliver strong, coordinated and comprehensive action to prepare every learner to acquire the knowledge, skills, values and attitudes to tackle climate change and to promote sustainable development. The Greening Education Partnership (GEP) consists of four key pillars, including four main aims to be reached in UN member states by 2030:

1. Greening Schools:

All countries will have adopted a green school accreditation scheme with at least 50% schools, colleges, and universities with green accreditation and operating sustainably.

2. Greening Learning:

The number of countries which include climate education in school curricula at the pre-primary, primary, and secondary levels will have at least doubled from the current ~ 45%

3. Greening Teacher Capacity & Readiness:

All school leaders and at least 1 teacher per school will have been trained on how to integrate climate education into teaching and learning throughout the school.

4. Greening Communities:

All countries will be able to report at least 3 different ways learning opportunities are made available for adults outside the formal education system to develop the skills, attitudes, and actions that will foster community resilience to tackle climate change.

In Malaysia, there are more than 250 Eco-Schools as of 2022.

The three-year programme aims to build a community of young people who care for the environment. It was developed by the Foundation for Environmental Education based in Denmark and endorsed by the Ministry of Education Malaysia.



THE RACE TOWARDS 1000 ECO SCHOOLS

Eco-Schools Malaysia programme has been selected as a key high-impact low-hanging project for Education for Sustainable Development under the Green City Action Plan. Malaysia aims to achieve 1000 Eco-Schools by 2025, setting the target of 100 Eco-Schools for each of the 14 states. The Race Towards 1000 Eco-Schools was launched as a national agenda in July 2022 when GGAF officially became the national operator appointed by the Foundation for Environmental Education.

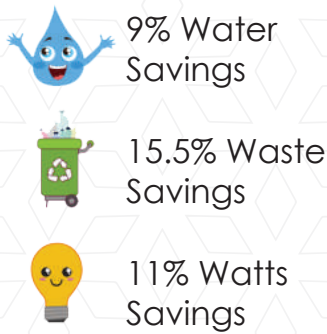
ESP 7-STEP METHODOLOGY

The Eco-Schools Seven Steps methodology is a series of carefully engineered measures to help schools maximise the success of their Eco-School ambitions.

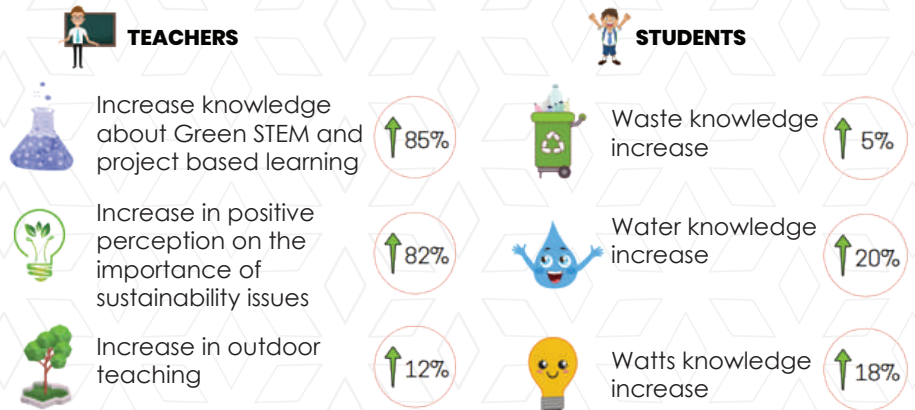

INSIDE THE SCHOOL

- 84%** of the school principals have noticed a better cohesion between teachers
- 84%** of school teachers say they learnt how to work together through Eco-Schools Programme
- 8/10** of school teachers use Eco-Schools modules in the learning process of new competencies

AT HOME

- 3/4** parents have observed their child had learned new skills and thanks to the Eco-Schools Programme
- 8/10** Parents have adopted a new behaviour about litter handling (selective collecting, reusable bags, batteries recycling)

IN THE COMMUNITY

- 83%** of local authorities think Eco-Schools Programme helps to raise biodiversity awareness among their agents incharge of green areas
- 87%** of schools have installed hosting areas for wildlife (nest box etc)
